Description	Calcium acetate is a powder which is used as a hardening agent for mineral oil based Blasocut emulsions, acting as an antifoam.
Properties	Efficient, long-term antifoam for use in Blasocut emulsions. The water hardness, together with Blasocut, forms fine calcium soap which effectively prevents foaming.
	Not to be used, since not effective, with Vasco 5000, synthetic Grindex and Synergy products.
When to use it	When fresh or used Blasocut emulsions show an increased foaming tendency, especially in soft water or if the permissible water hardness is not reached.
How to use it	Dosage: 30 g calcium acetate per 1'000 liters of emulsion hardens by 1° dH 17 g calcium acetate per 1'000 liters of emulsion hardens by 1° fH 17 g calcium acetate per 1000 liters of emulsion hardens by 10 ppm
Handling/Storage	Protect against moisture. Storage: Store in closed original container at temperature from +5°C to
	+40°C (41°F to 104°F). Protect against frost. Do not expose to direct sunlight. Transport: No hazardous good according to ADR
